

Sample Will Wording:

1. A general bequest designates a certain dollar amount of property, usually cash, to the charity you select:
“I give to the QEII Health Sciences Centre Foundation the sum of \$10,000 to be used for the general purposes at the discretion of the Board of Directors”.
2. A specific bequest directs that the Foundation is to receive a specific piece of property:
“I give to the QEII Health Sciences Centre Foundation 500 shares of XYZ stock...”
3. A residual bequest designates for the charity all, or a portion, of whatever remains after all debts, taxes, expenses and other bequests have been paid:
“I give to the QEII Health Sciences Centre Foundation fifty percent (50 percent) of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate...”
4. A contingent bequest takes effect only under certain conditions:
“In the event my wife does not survive me, I give to the QEII Health Sciences Centre Foundation the sum of...”
