

The Camp Hill Veterans' Memorial Garden at the QEII Health Sciences Centre is a hidden gem not far from busy Robie Street in Halifax. A private sanctuary of colourful flowers, sheltering trees, and pruned shrubs, this private refuge is an area designed for the approximate 175 Veterans who reside at the Camp Hill Veterans' Memorial Building.

The Veterans' Memorial Garden was created in 2000. Through generous donations, a dull parking lot was transformed into this beautiful retreat for the Veterans, their families and their caregivers.

A large portion of the funding for the on-going support and care of the Garden is provided by kind donors. In addition, the Stadacona Band Joint Task Force Atlantic annually presents *The Battle of the Atlantic* musical gala in the spring, and *'Til We Meet Again* concert in the fall, both in partnership with the QEII Foundation. These concerts have been highly successful and since 1999, they have consistently sold out.

Walk of Honour - \$300

This marble structure consists of multiple panels with engraved names of individuals or groups who have served in conflict. Honour your loved one by adding their name to the structure.



Tree or Shrub - \$750

Trees and shrubs are found throughout the Garden and provide beauty and shade to Garden guests. Your gift will dedicate a tree or shrub with an inscribed plaque in honour or in memory of your loved one.



Bench - \$1500

Benches provide a resting spot for Veterans and their guests. An engraved plaque with the name of your loved one will accompany the bench situated in the Garden.

Keep the Garden Growing

Much of the Camp Hill Veterans' Memorial Garden is designed with horticulture therapy in mind because flowers and plants can be extremely powerful therapeutic medicine. The entire Garden is wheelchair accessible and fully enclosed, making it a safe haven for the Veterans.

The Veterans are able to use and explore the full Garden unaided, including the cenotaph which was erected for those who fought in World War I, World War II, and the Korean War.
